However, for best results the lawn should receive $\frac{1}{2}$ to $\frac{1}{2}$ inch of water from rainfall or irrigation within 2-3 days after application.

Apply in early spring before the third or fourth mowing, or before temperatures are regularly in the 80s. Rain, snow, or freezing weather will not affect the performance of this product.

Note: Product applies 1.50 lbs pendimethalin per acre in 3.1 lbs of product per 1000 square feet at the Regular Rate. It applies 2.0 lbs pendimethalin per acre in 4.1 lbs of product per 1000 square feet at the Heavy Rate.

- For Kentucky bluegrass, fine fescue, tall fescue, perennial ryegrass, and blends of these grasses, apply at the REGULAR RATE.

Apply in the fall (August - October), after temperatures have cooled and fall rains have begun, to prevent moss (except in California) from becoming established during winter or next spring, or to prevent germination of <u>Poa</u> annua and chickweed.

Use Precautions

- Do not apply to newly seeded or sodded areas until after the fourth mowing. On newly sprigged areas, wait 5 months before application.

 Do not seed or sod for 4 months following application. The crabgrass barrier
- prevents grass seed from sprouting. Not for use on dichondra, bentgrass or St. Augustinegrass lawns.

Entry Restriction
