How To Use

Apply prior to or after sprigging or on established turf at 203 to 271 lbs. of product per acre for suppression or control of listed annual grassy weeds.

After application of this product on newly sprigged bermudagrass and St. Augustinegrass, wait until the grass has filled in and the stolons have rooted down before application of other PROTURF herbicide, combination fertilizer/herbicide or growth regulator products.

ProTurf fertilizers, fungicides and insecticides can be applied as needed.

When To Use

Use this product to control or suppress the listed annual grassy weeds when establishing new turf areas or when treating established turf that has been thinned from winter injury, insects, diseases or other factors.

Precautions

Avoid contact with flowers and shrubs.

This product should not be used on established putting greens and tees because of the varied cultural practices used.

Do not apply product to moist turfgrass foliage.

This product may cause discoloration of bermudagrass and St. Augustinegrass. This discoloration is temporary and will normally be outgrown within 2 to 3 weeks.
