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Directions for use

Not for use on turf being grown for sale or other commercial use as sod, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes.

For use on established bermudagrass, bluegrass, ryegrass, St. Augustinegrass, tall fescue, and zoysia turfgrasses for preemergent control or suppression of sprouting:

Grassy Weeds
crabgrass
goosegrass
green foxtail
Poa annua
yellow foxtail

Dicot Weeds
Florida pusley
oxtails
pigweed
stinging nettle

How to use

Provides control of sprouting annual grassy and dicot weeds in established turf, thus eliminating the development of large weed plants that smother the desirable turfgrasses.

Allow one week between the application of this and other control products. (This guideline can be relaxed where severe insect or disease attack requires immediate treatment.)

After this product has been applied for two to three consecutive years and annual grassy weeds have been effectively controlled, further application should be withheld until need is established.

Prior to seeding or sprigging, the soil surface should be disturbed or worked to dilute any remaining chemical residue.

Not for use on dichondra, centipedegrass, red fescue and bentgrass or *Poa annua* if it is the desired species.

Disturbance of the soil surface after application of this product will disrupt the herbicide barrier and reduce the effectiveness.

When to use

Crabgrass and Goosegrass Control: For preemergent control, apply 163 to 435 pounds per acre (1.5 to 4 pounds of active ingredient) in early spring prior to weed seed germination. Applications made after March or April may not be fully effective. If the half rate is used (163 lbs. product/A), a repeat application of 163 lbs. of product in 6 to 10 weeks is recommended.

Annual Bluegrass Control: For preemergent control, apply 435 pounds per acre (4 pounds of active ingredient) in late summer to early fall or in early spring prior to weed germination.

Pigweed, Florida Pusley, Oxtails, Stinging Nettle, and Carpetgrass Control: For preemergent control of these weeds, apply 435 pounds per acre (4 pounds of active ingredient) in early spring prior to weed seed germination.

Precautions

Avoid contact with flowers and shrubs.
