• For use on established or sprigged bermudagrass, zoysiagrass, Seashore paspalum (see precautions), and St. Augustinegrass ornamental turf for preemergent control or suppression of sprouting: crabgrass, yellow foxtail, *Poa annua*, goosegrass and green foxtail.

HOW TO USE

- Apply 200 to 300 lbs. of product per acre (2.0 to 3.0 lbs. ai/acre) prior to or after sprigging for suppression or control of listed annual grassy weeds in bermudagrass, zoysiagrass, and St. Augustinegrass.
- After application of this product on newly sprigged bermudagrass, zoysiagrass, and St. Augustinegrass, wait until the grass has taken root and the stolons have rooted down before application of other PROTURF herbicide, combination fertilizer/herbicide or growth regulator products.
- On Seashore paspalum make application 10-14 days after sprigging.
- For established turf, apply at 200 to 300 lbs. of product per acre (2.0 to 3.0 lbs. ai/acre).

WHEN TO USE

Use this product to control or suppress the listed annual grassy weeds when establishing new turf areas or when treating established turf that has been thinned from winter injury, insects, diseases or other factors.

PRECAUTIONS

- Avoid contact with flowers and shrubs.
- This product should not be used on established putting greens and tees because of the varied cultural practices used.
- Do not apply product to moist turfgrass foliage.
