Dear Mr. Wible:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide. Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable subject to the following conditions:

- Under Active Ingredient, change the percentages of Inert Ingredient to "99.7 99.0%" to a. match the myclobutanil percentage range.
- Add "Net Contents" to the bottom of front panel. b.
- Move "Recommended for Use by Professional Turf Grass Managers" from page 2 to C. page 1 below the product name.
- d. Under Note carefully, change the first sentence to read, "Do not apply more than 2.88 oz active ingredient/1000 sq.ft/year". You cannot recommend an application rate for the finished product without giving the corresponding active ingredient (AI) percent. For example, the application of 46.2 lb of product/1000 sq.ft (the maximum rate/year you recommended in the submitted label) would deliver 2.22 - 7.39 oz AI/1000 sq.ft depending upon the nominal concentration of 0.3 to 1.0%. It is acceptable to give the application rate in Al; however, users will have to calculate the quantity of finished product based on the Al concentration.

- e. Under **Note carefully**, in addition, change the second sentence to read "Do not apply more than 0.72 oz active ingredient/1000 sq.ft/year" for the same reason as stated above.
- f. Please submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

Since Fungicide XI is being marketed in different AI concentrations ranging from 0.3% to 1.0% myclobutanil, please let us know what concentrations you marketed in 1998 and submit a copy of each label.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release of the product for shipment constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A stamped copy of the draft label is enclosed for your records.

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TO PREVENT DOLLAR SPOT, ANTHRACNOSE, POWDERY MILDEW, AND RUST (Pucinna spp.) apply to moist or dry foliage at the RECOMMENDED RATE when environmental conditions favor disease activity. Repeat the application at 2 week intervals throughout the expected disease period.

TO CONTROL ACTIVE DOLLARSPOT, ANTHRACNOSE, POWDERY MILDEW, AND RUST (Pucinna spp.) apply to moist or dry foliage at two week intervals. Use the DOUBLE RATE for light to moderate disease infestations and the HEAVY RATE for severe disease infestations.
