Subject: Label Amendment- Addition of Alternate Directions for Use and Residual Claims for Fire Ants

EPA Registration No. 538-260 Turf Builder with Fire Ant-X

Your submission dated May 7, 2004

Dear Ms. Kendrick:

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under section 3 (c) (7) (A) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable provided that you:

- 1. Delete "tough" from "... insect control". There is no category of "tough insects". You may list specific pests appearing on the list of pests in the back panel of the label.
- 2. Claims that imply heightened efficacy, total control, eradication, are not acceptable. Delete "death to insects, controls most insect problems, cures.., rid...insect free, eliminates/destroys/eradicates, keeps ants away, protective barrier, complete control, strengthens against future insects, kills fleas and ticks before they get on your pet..."
- 3. Replace "destroys" with "kills" fire ants throughout the label.
- 4. Change "yard" to "lawns". The only area being treated is the lawn.
- 5. Delete all bullets under "How it works". Words or phrases implying that a product possesses unique characteristics because of its composition are not acceptable.

6. As per our October 24, 2000 letter, delete all references to controlling, destroying, and/or preventing fire ant mounds/colonies. This product will kill foraging ants, but not the mounds.

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- 7. Delete *chiggers* and *spiders* from the pest list. You have cited no data to support claims for these public health pests.
- 8. Replace "fleas" with "fleas (larvae)".
- 9. Delete "special active ingredient". See comment 5 above.
- 10. Delete "*Protects ...family...from pests.*" Vague or ambiguous terms stating or implying safety to humans or the environment are not acceptable.
- 11. Delete the "up to 4 months" residual control claims throughout the label. This claim is not supported by data cited to support this amendment. The cited data supports residual control of foraging ants for broadcast applications at 0.25 lb ai/acre. Residential use applications of bifenthrin products are restricted to 0.20 lb ai/acre. Additionally, the subject product contains half of the active ingredient (w/w) of the cited product, and the use directions provided are vague with regard to application rates. You must either cite or submit data demonstrating the proposed residual control claim at 0.20 lb ai/acre. Note that the application rate for this product cannot exceed 0.20 lb ai/acre.
- 12. Submit two (2) copies of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

MOLE CRICKETS: Make application as late in the day as possible and water with 1/2 inch of water. If the soil is not moist prior to application, it may be necessary to irrigate first to bring mole crickets closer to the surface where they are more likely to contact the insecticide. Let the lawn foliage dry and then apply Turf Builder® with Fire Ant-X. Mole crickets are best controlled by treating the young nymphs. For best control, treat prior to peak egg hatch in the spring.

FIRE ANTS: You should treat your entire lawn every two months. A broadcast application will control foraging workers and new fly-in females. For best results, treat during the morning or late evening when it is cool and the fire ants are most active. FLEA LARVAE: Water in with 1/2 inch of water. Flea larvae develop in the soil of shaded areas where pets frequent.

TICKS: Apply in the spring when ticks are first noticed. A light watering (1/10 inch) is required to activate the insecticide. Retreat as needed.

ARMYWORMS, CUTWORMS, SOD WEBWORMS: Water with 1/10 inch of water after application to activate the insecticide.
