Dear Ms. McLaughlin:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Two (2) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

- 1. Under <u>Chinch Bugs</u> either delete "Repeat applications throughout the growing season as needed or indicate the repeat interval which should be based upon the residual effectiveness of the product.
- 2. Revise the follow Optional Front Panel Claims:
 - a. Replace "Specially formulated for warm weather/season grasses [the hottest months]" with "Formulated for warm weather/season grasses [the hottest months]".
 - b. Replace "Specially formulated not to burn summertime lawns" with "Formulated not to burn summertime lawns".
 - c. Replace "Formulated to kill/control insects, won't harm lawns" with "Formulated to kill/control listed insects, won't harm lawns".
 - d. Replace "Kills/controls ants/fire ants/fleas (larvae)/ticks/mole crickets/chinch bugs/other lawn-damaging insects" with "Kills/controls ants/fire ants/fleas (larvae)/ticks/mole crickets/chinch bugs/other listed lawn-damaging insects".
- 3. Delete the claim "For outdoor multi-insect control. [as listed]". This claim implies a greater range of effectiveness than labeled. Claims must be limited to those pests listed on the label.

4. Delete all references to claims for Pharaoh's Ants and Centipedes. The data submitted and cited do not support these claims.

General Use Instructions

- Apply as soon as insect activity or damage is first observed in the lawn.
- Spread uniformly over your lawn using the suggested spreader settings. For best results, use a Scotts® spreader.
- Apply when the lawn foliage is dry. Water lightly immediately after application. See specific instructions on watering below.
- Re-treat as needed but not more than four times a year.

Specific instructions

CHINCH BUGS: A moderate watering-in (up to 1/4 inch) is necessary to reach the chinch bugs which are found in the thatch layer. Make applications in early spring or whenever chinch bug activity is noticed. Repeat applications throughout the growing season as needed.

MOLE CRICKETS: Make application as late in the day as possible and water with 1/2 inch of water. If the soil is not moist prior to application, it may be necessary to irrigate first to bring mole crickets closer to the surface where they are more likely to contact the insecticide. Let the lawn foliage dry and then apply Turf Builder® with Fire Ant-X. Mole crickets are best controlled by treating the young nymphs. For best control, treat prior to peak egg hatch in the spring.

FIRE ANTS: Treat your entire lawn every two months. A broadcast application will control foraging workers and new fly-in females. For best results, treat during the morning or late evening when it is cool and the fire ants are most active. For control, treat established mounds with a mound control product 2-3 days prior to applying Turf Builder® with Fire Ant-X.

FLEA LARVAE: Water in with 1/2 inch of water. Flea larvae develop in the soil of shaded areas where pets frequent.

TICKS: Apply in the spring when ticks are first noticed. Water with 1/10 inch of water is required to activate the insecticide.

ARMYWORMS, CUTWORMS, SOD WEBWORMS: Water with 1/10 inch of water after application to activate the insecticide.
