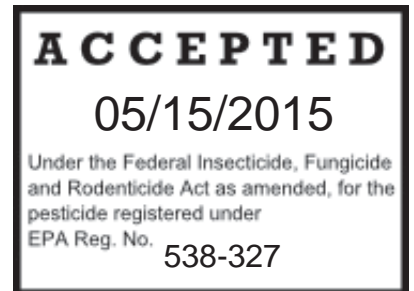

LAWN AND PERIMETER APPLICATIONS

Perimeter Application: Apply to lawn area 6 to 10 feet wide around and adjacent to the structure using an application rate of 3.33 to 6.66 pounds per 1,000 square feet.

Lawn Application: Broadcast Scotts Turf Fertilizer with Ortho Max Pro II [product name/this product] with suitable application equipment to ensure uniform coverage over the treatment area. Apply 3.33 to 6.66 pounds per 1,000 square feet to control the following pests:

¹Imported Fire Ants: Control will be optimized by combining broadcast applications that will control foraging workers and newly mated fly-in queens with mound treatments [(using another product registered for fire ant mound treatment)] that will control existing colonies.

²The higher application rate may be required to control Ants, Centipedes, Chinch Bugs, Fleas, Imported Fire Ants, Millipedes, Mole Crickets and Ticks.

In New York State, this product may NOT be applied to any grass or turf area within 100 feet of a water body (lake, pond, river, stream, wetland, or drainage ditch).
