The Registration Division (RD) has conducted a review of this request for its applicability under PRN 98-10 and finds that the action requested falls within the scope of PRN 98-10. The label submitted with the application has been stamped "NOTIFICATION" and placed in our records.

The alternate brand names, "Scotts Max Fall Weed & Feed I" and "Scotts Max Weed & Feed I" have been added to the product record.
