

**HOW TO USE WITH SEARS SPRAYER**

- Use 4 oz. (8 tablespoons) oil spray to 1 gallon of water (1 gallon to 33 gallons of water); stir vigorously.
- For best results use a Sears Sprayer.
- Spray thoroughly on parts of plants.
- Apply as a Spring dormant application. Do not spray until after bud break after any sign of bud break or new growth.
- Make 1 or 2 applications at and when trees are sometimes affected by oil sprays. Don't spray them unless it is absolutely necessary.

**CAN BE USED ON:**

**Plants:**

Apple, Peach, Cherry, Plum, Apricot and Pear, Dogwood, Elm, Magnolia, Oak, Euonymus, Holly, Flowering Quince and Spirea

**Insects:**

San Jose Scale, Scurfy Scale, Leaf Roller Eggs and Red Mite Eggs, Cottony Maple Scale, Red Mite Eggs, San Jose Scale and Euonymus Scale
