DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For control of general insect feeders such as flea beetles, cucumber beetles, young mealy bugs, garden fleahoppers, aphids, thrips, beet webworms and army worms feeding on Irish potatoes, beans, peas, cucumbers, beets and tomatoes.

- For control of specific insect feeders such as:
- Cabbage worms and young harlequin cabbage bugs (nymphs), feeding on cabbage, cauliflower and broccoli.
 - Vegetable weevils feeding on carrots, turnips, and beets.
 - Mexican bean beetles on beans.
 - Bean leaf beetles and pea weevils on beans and peas.
 - Melon worms, young squash bugs (nymphs) and squash vine borers feeding on squash, cucumbers, pumpkins, and related plants.
 - Leafhoppers feeding on potatoes and beans.
 - Potato beetles on potatoes, tomatoes and eggplants.
 - Small tomato fruitworms and small tomato hornworms on tomatoes.
 - Asparagus beetles on asparagus.
 - Pepper weevils on peppers.
 - Young leaf-footed plant bugs (nymphs) on tomatoes, beans, and peas.

Apply Vegetable Garden Dust lightly when insects first appear. Dust both tops and bottoms of leaves. If properly applied, dust will be hardly visible on the plants. Repeat at weekly intervals until pests are controlled.

NOTE: Do not repeat application to asparagus within three days and do not apply within one day of harvest. Do not use within three days of harvest of broccoli, cabbage, head lettuce, Brussels sprouts, cauliflower, kohlrabi, and within one day of harvest of other vegetables except the vegetables listed below. Do not apply within 14 days of harvest of leaf lettuce, parsley, spinach, beet tops, turnip tops, Swiss chard.

CAUTION: Harmful if inhaled or swallowed. Do not breathe dust. Do not take internally. Skin contact may be harmful. Avoid contact with skin. Wash thoroughly after using. Wash hands before eating. Keep out of reach of children. Avoid contamination of food.

Note for Physician: Carbaryl is a moderate reversible, cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal.
