RECOMMENDATIONS and DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Lawn and Turf: Chinch Bugs -- apply 12 lbs. of this material on 2,000 sq. ft. (40' x 50') of lawn. Most garden fertilizer spreaders when set on the number used for small grass seed will correctly distribute this material (For example use setting #6 for Sears Calibrated Spreader, #5 for 20" rotary spreaders, #5 for Cyclone Spreader). Immediately after application, drench with water or sprinkle thoroughly. Do not allow persons or pets on treated lawn until grass is completely dry.

CAUTION: HAZARDOUS IF SWALLOWED. Avoid breathing dust, contact with skin and eyes. Wear gloves. Wash hands with soap and water before eating, smoking and after using. Do not contaminate feed and foodstuffs. STORE OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Trithion*, upon repeated, prolonged and careless use, may cause cholinesterase inhibition. ATROPINE IS ANTIDOTAL.
