DIRECTIONS

FOR GENERAL SANITATION, such as washing floors, commodes, bath tubs, sinks or bedpans, use 1 part of PURITAN STAR-PINE to 99 parts of water (about 3/4 cup in 2-1/2 gallons of water). Wet all surfaces. For charging cuspidors, use 2 tablespoons PURITAN STAR-PINE per cup of water.

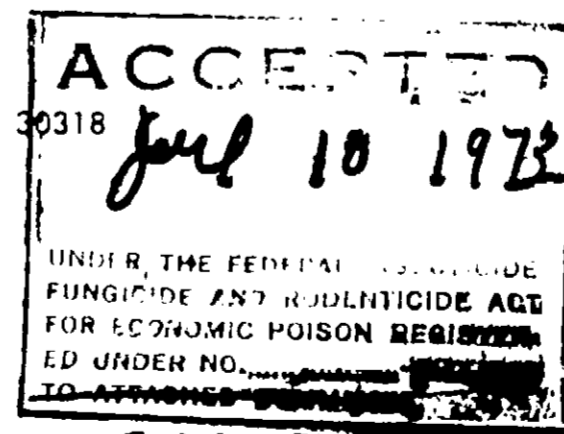
