

SAF-T-FOG BRAND

INSECTICIDE

Kills Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Roaches, Waterbugs, Silverfish, Crickets, Spiders, Grain Weevils, Grain Moths, Flour Beetles, Grain Mites, Ants, Fleas, Brown Dog Ticks, Bedbugs and Carpet Beetles.

Consists of (butylcarbityl), (6-propylpiperonyl) ether and related compounds.

In use, SAF-T-FOG BRAND INSECTICIDE is rated by U.L. between 15 and 20 classed between paraffin and kerosene.



DIRECTIONS

PURITAN SAF-T-FOG BRAND INSECTICIDE is a highly concentrated material and may be diluted before spraying for reduction of flying insect populations by mixing 1 gallon of concentrate with 6 gallons of kerosene, fuel oil or horticultural base oil. For heavy infestation of flying insects, and for use as a surface or residual spray against crawling insects, a dilution of 1:3 is recommended.

AS A SPACE SPRAY FOR FLYING INSECTS: For flies, mosquitoes and gnats, close all openings and turn off air conditioning and ventilating systems. Cover all foodstuffs to prevent contamination from flying insects. For best results in large areas, dilute with an electric sprayer. Adjust nozzle to produce a very fine cloud of mist. Spray approximately 2 minutes per each 500 cu. ft. of space. Leave room closed for at least 10 minutes after spraying. Remove and destroy all insects. Repeat application as often as necessary.

AS A SURFACE SPRAY FOR CRAWLING INSECTS: For roaches, waterbugs, silverfish, crickets, spiders. Use a coarse spray that will not float in the air. Direct this spray to baseboards, roofwork and areas around dra. pipes to insure a heavy deposit. Repeat when necessary.

FOR GRAIN WEEVILS, GRAIN MOTHS, FLOUR BEETLES AND GRAIN MITES: (Accessible stages) Wet surfaces thoroughly and treat all infested surface areas, insect hiding places and insect runways. Spray to assist of removal. Repeat when necessary.

FOR FLEAS AND BROWN DOG TICKS IN BUILDINGS: Spray lower wall portions, baseboards, rugs, carpets and floors along animal quarters, kennels and bedding should also be sprayed. Repeat when necessary.

FOR BEDBUGS: Spray base and mattress including all tufts, seams and folds, springs and mattress with wood bed frames and hiding places. All bedding before using. Repeat when necessary.

FOR CARPET BEETLES: Spray of all areas of carpets, local areas of floors, baseboards, walls and ceilings where insects may be found. Repeat when necessary.

GENERAL SAF-T-FOG BRAND INSECTICIDE may be used as a foliage insecticide most and non-flowering plants. Do not spray plants directly when plant is out in operation. Plants should be sprayed or covered during treatment and field producing systems should be covered or thoroughly cleaned before using.

CAUTION: Keep out of reach of children.

Do not use near open flame. When fogging indoors all fires, flames, pilot lights and the sources of ignition must be extinguished and safely shut off. The National Fire Protection Association advises that not more than one gallon of any solvent based formulation should be used for each 1000 cu. ft. of space. Proportional quantities should be used for smaller or larger volumes.

Do not smoke when spraying. Remove pets, birds, and fish bowls before applying. Do not spray on food, feed, bedding, or drinking utensils, or on asphalt, tin or copper. Do not breathe the spray.
