DIRECTIONS

DI-BROCIDE-50 is a highly concentrated material and should be diluted before fogging by mixing 1 gallon of the concentrate with 50 gallons of kerosene, fuel oil, mineral seal oil or horticultural base oil. For heavy infestations, a dilution of 1 to 29 is recommended. Use within a few days after mixing. Do not store diluted spray. Do not mix with water.

FOR OUTDOOR SPACE SPRAYING AND REDUCTION OF AIRBORNE INSECT POPULATIONS: For Flies, Mosquitoes, Wasps, and Gnats, disperse with fogging apparatus, smoke generator or pressure sprayer.

FOR OUTDOOR RESIDUAL SPRAYING: For control of Flies, Mosquitoes, Roaches, Waterbugs, Ants and Spiders, mix 1 gallon of DI-BROCIDE-50 with 29 gallons of suitable solvent and apply as a coarse, wet spray on garbage dumps, athletic fields, drive-in theaters, camp sites, and around buildings. For outdoor meeting places, spray several hours in advance of the desired period of protection. To prevent entry of flies, mosquitoes or wasps into human dwellings, apply to screens, window frames, doorsills and areas on porches where insects congregate. Heavy application is desirable for the most effective kill and greatest residual effect. Do not apply or allow to drift to areas occupied by unprotected humans or beneficial animals. Repeat application when necessary.

WARNING (18 pt.) Keep out of reach of children (12 pt.)

May be fatal if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Do not spray on humans or animals or near fish bowls. Do not treat food crop areas. Do not contaminate feed, water, foodstuff, utensils, dishes or drinking water. Do not breathe spray mist or contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Use natural rubber gloves and face shield or goggles when handling the concentrate. In case of contact with skin or eyes, wash with plenty of water; for eyes, get medical attention. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking; wear clean clothing. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not smoke while spraying. If swallowed, induce vomiting immediately and get medical attention. Atropine is antidotal.

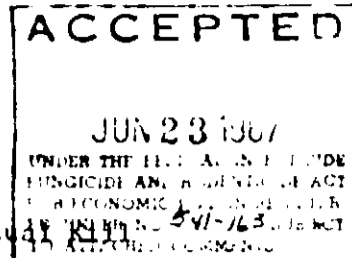
