

### **DIRECTIONS**

GOSSAMER is highly concentrated and should be diluted before use. As little as I ounce is sufficient to soften, to condition, to germ-proof, and to render 50 pounds of linens bacteriostatic, where a ratio of 3.5-5.0 pounds of water per pound of fabric is employed. In special cases, where extra softening and extra anti-bacterial activity are desired, use higher application levels. Two ounces per 50 pounds will make fabric germ-proof egainst both gram negative and gram positive organisms, and 3 ounces per 50 pounds will make fabric self-sanitizing. At the latter level the treated fabric will effectively reduce 99% of the bacteria which the fabric encounters during use and will inhibit growth of the remaining bacteria.

In Industrial Wash Wheels: Where machine holds 50 pounds of clothes and provides several wash and rinse cycles, add as little as I ounce of GOSSAMER to the final rinse. Pump I ounce from jug and disperse in cup containing 6 to 8 ounces of water; then pour contents of cup into machine.

Complete wash cycle follows — for 50 pounds of clothes:

### **DIRECTIONS:** Continued from other side panel

- A. First wash ("Break" wash 5-6 minutes): 6-8 ounces of VIGOR or T.L.D.
- B. Second wash (Also 5-6 minutes): 2-4 ounces of VIGOR or TL.D.
  - C. Clear rins a.
- D. Bleach rinse: I ounce of PURITAN #120 BLEACH.
- F. Sour rinse: 3/3-1 ounce of PURITAN #303 SOUR.
  - G. Conditioning rinse: I ounce of GOSSAMER.

In Small Machines: In self service launderettes or in home washing machines, where capacity is about 9 to 10 pounds of clothes. I ounce is sufficient. Disperse GOSSAMER in a cup of water and add to final rinse.
