


PURITAN #3387

#### DIRECTIONS

PURITAN #3387 is a highly concentrated material and should be diluted before fogging by mixing 1 gallon of the concentrate with 100 gallons of kerosene, fuel oil, mineral seal oil or horticulturas base oil. Use within a few days after mixing. Do not store diluted spray. Do not mix with water.

FOR OUTDOOR SPACE SPRAYING & REDUCTION OF AIRBORNE INSECT POPULATIONS: For Flies, Mosquitoes, Wasps and Gnats, disperse with fogging apparatus, smoke generator or pressure sprayer.

For fogging, use any device in which an oil based insecticide may be used. Thermal foggers, such as the various model Dyna-Fogs, are especially useful. With foggers or carriers, apply at the rate of 40 gallons per hour output, at an average vehicle speed of 5 miles per hour, applying swath 300 to 400 feet wide. Detailed directions are also available for application from airplanes. See your Puritan Representative.

WING (18 pt.): Keep out of reach of children (12 pt.)

May be fatal if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Do not spray on humans or animals or near fish bowls. Do not contaminate feed, water, foodstuffs, utensils, dishes, or drinking water. Do not breathe spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Use waterproof gloves and face shield or goggles when handling the concentrate. In case of contact with skin or eyes, wash with plenty of water; for eyes, get medical attention. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking; wear clothing. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not smoke while spraying. If swallowed, induce vomiting immediately and get medical attention. Atropine is antidotal. This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Keep out of lakes, streams and ponds. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

Do not re-use empty container. Destroy when empty.
