DIRECTIONS

Puritan #4583 is a highly concentrated material and should be diluted before fogging by mixing 1 gallon of the concentrate with 10 gallons of kerosene, fuel oil, mineral seal oil or horticultural base oil. For heavy infestation, a dilution of 1 to 5 is recommended. Use within a few days after mixing. Do not store diluted spray. Do not mix with water.

FOR OUTDOOR SPACE SPRAYING: For mosquitoes, flies and gnats, dispense with fogging apparatus or mist sprayer. Adjust fogging machine to deliver equivalent of 50 gallons per hour at a machine speed of 5 m.p.h. to cover a swath wide up to 350 feet. Total area covered is equivalent to 2-2 1/2 acres. The area treated should be completely covered with visible fog or at the rate of 2 pints of Puritan #4583 per acre. This dilution is equivalent to 0.1125 lbs. of active insecticide ingredient per acre. Repeat as necessary. Do not apply or allow to drift to areas occupied by unprotected human or beneficial animals.

FOR OUTDOOR RESIDUAL SPRAYING: For control of flies, mosquitoes, roaches, waterbugs, ants and spiders, mix 1 gallon with 2 gallons of suitable solvent and apply as a spray, mist or fog, at the rate of 1 gallon per 1,000 sq. ft., on large open areas, work sheds, driver's quarters, camp grounds and other buildings. For outdoor hanging places, allow several hours in coverage of the treated portion of protection. To prevent entry of flies and gnats, pour into Puritan #4583, apply to screens, window frames, doors and other areas on corners where insects may gather. Heavy duty screens are desirable for the greatest effect. Rinse and wash treated insects. Do not apply or allow to drift to areas occupied by unprotected human and beneficial animals.

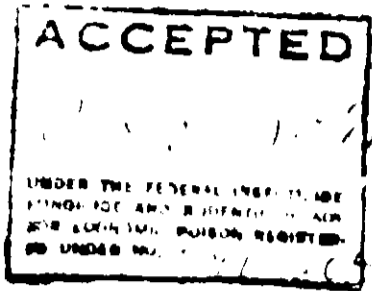
