



DIRECTIONS

This product is designed for use by Pest Control Operators or other trained personnel only.

WATERLOO is a highly concentrated material and should be diluted before fogging by mixing 1 gallon of the concentrate with 10 gallons of kerosene, fuel oil, mineral oil or horticultural base oil. For heavy infestations, a dilution of 1 to 6 is recommended.

FOR OUTDOOR SPACE SPRAYING & REDUCTION OF AIRBORNE INSECT POPULATIONS: For flies, mosquitoes, wasps and gnats, disperse with fogging apparatus or mist generator. When mixed 1 part of concentrate to 10 parts of solvent, apply approximately 6-1/2 gallons of this mixture per acre. For heavy infestations, mix 1 part of concentrate to 6 parts of solvent and apply at same dosage rate per unit of area. Adjust fogging machine to deliver equivalent of 40 gallons per hour at a machine speed

of 5 m.p.h. to cover a swath width of up to 350 feet, and fog until proper dosage rate per unit area has been applied. Repeat as necessary.

FOR OUTDOOR RESIDUAL SPRAYING: For control of flies, mosquitoes, roaches, waterbugs, ants and spiders, mix 1 gallon of concentrate with 5 gallons of suitable solvent and apply as a coarse, wet spray on garbage dumps, athletic fields, drive-in theatres, camp sites and around industrial buildings and factories. For outdoor meeting places, spray several hours in advance of the desired period of protection. To prevent entry of flies, mosquitoes or wasps into human dwellings, apply to screens, window frames, doorsills and areas on porches where insects congregate. Heavy application is desirable for the most effective kill and greatest residual effect. Do not apply or allow to drift to areas occupied by unprotected humans or beneficial animals. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Repeat application when necessary.
