DIRECTIONS

Puritan #4677 should be diluted before fogging by mixing 1 gallon of the concentrate with 9 gallons of kerosene, fuel oil, mineral seal oil or horticultural base oil. For heavy infestations, a dilution of 1 to 6 is recommended.

FOR OUTDOOR SPACE SPRAYING: For mosquitoes, flies and gnats, disperse with fogging apparatus or mist sprayer. Adjust fogging machine to deliver equivalent of 40 gallons per hour at a machine speed of 5 m.p.h. to cover a swath width up to 350 feet. (Total area covered is equivalent to 21.21 acres.) The area treated should be completely covered with visible fog or at the rate of 2 pints of Puritan #4677 per acre. (This dilution is equivalent to 0.16 lbs. of Malathion per acre.) Repeat as necessary. Do not apply or allow to drift to areas occupied by unprotected humans or beneficial animals.

Do not spray on humans or animals or near fish bowls. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs, utensils, dishes or drinking water. Vapor harmful. Avoid inhalation of mist or contact with skin. In case of contact with skin or eyes, wash with plenty of water; for eyes, get medical attention. Wash with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking; wear clean clothing. **DO NOT USE, POUR, SPILL OR STORE NEAR HEAT OR OPEN FLAME.** Do not smoke while spraying. If swallowed, induce vomiting immediately, and get medical attention. Atropine is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

Do not spray Puritan #4677, or any other solvent-based insecticide, directly on grass, plants, shrubs or other green vegetation, since solvents are quite destructive to vegetation. Do not reuse empty drum. Return to drum reconditioner or destroy by perforating or crushing and burying in a safe place.

This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment, or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.
