Statement of Practical Treatment

In case of contact immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of
water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes call a physician. Remove
and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites,
gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities
of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate
the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory
shock, as well as oxygen and measures to support breathing
manually or mechanically, may be needed. If persistent convulsions
may be controlled by the cautious intravenous injection of a
short-acting barbiturate drug.

Directions for Use GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner
inconsistent with its labeling.

**FOR GENERAL DISINFECTION, SANITIZATION AND
DEODORIZATION** of walls, floors, tables, woodwork, bedframes
and benches in hospital wards, sick rooms, operating rooms and
public rooms. Clean with suitable detergent and rinse thoroughly.
Apply with mop or cloth, solution containing 3 1/2 ounces of Puritan
#7402 in 5 gallons of water.

FOR SANITIZATION of dishes, glassware, silverware, cooking
utensils, bottles, milk cans, dairy and food processing equipment.
Clean with suitable detergent and rinse thoroughly. Immerse for 2
minutes in a sanitizing rinse made of 1 ounce of Puritan #7402 in 4
gallons of water. Air dry, do not use a towel. No rinses with potable
water required prior to re-use of equipment when this dilution is
used.

**FOR SANITIZING EQUIPMENT IN FOOD HANDLING ESTAB-
LISHMENTS INCLUDING MEAT AND POULTRY PROCESSING

then scrub with a solution of 1 ounce of Puritan #7402 per 4 gallons of water. Milk cans and other equipment should be air dried.

FOR COLD DISINFECTION OF SURGICAL INSTRUMENTS: Clean thoroughly, rinse and immerse in a solution of 1 ounce of Puritan #7402 per gallon of water for 10 minutes. One tablespoon of sodium nitrite should be added to each gallon of solution as a corrosive inhibitor.

FOR USE AS A POOL SIDE SURFACE GERMICIDE AND DEODORIZER. After cleaning, use 1 ounce of Puritan #7402 to 4 gallons of water for sanitizing, or 3 ounces to 5 gallons of water for disinfecting. Apply solution with mop or cloth.

NOTE: Do not use in conjunction with soap or synthetic detergents. Materials to be disinfected should first be washed and RINSED THOROUGHLY.

PURITAN #7402 is a concentrate and should be diluted before using.

PURITAN #7402 fulfills the criteria of Appendix F, The Grade A Pasteurized Milk Ordinance, 1965 Recommendations of the U.S. Public Health Service in waters up to 750 p.p.m. of hardness calculated as CaCO₃, when tested by the A.O.A.C. Germicidal and Detergent-Sanitizers—Official Method.
