DIRECTIONS

FOR FLIES, MOSQUITOES, AND GNATS: Close windows and doors. Spray freely toward ceiling in all directions until room is filled with mist, then leave the room. Keep doors closed for at least 15 minutes. Ventilate the room when treatment is completed.

FOR WASPS: Application should be made in the late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.

FLAMMABLE

DO NOT SMOKE WHILE SPRAYING. DO NOT USE, POUR, SPILL OR STORE NEAR HEAT OR OPEN FLAME.

Remove pets, birds and fish bowls before spraying. Do not spray directly on foodstuff, on eating or drinking utensils, or on asphalt tile or composition floors.

Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. When using the product in these areas, apply only when the facility is not in operation.

In hospitals remove patients from rooms to be treated. Fill room with mist. Rooms should be ventilated for 2 hours before returning patients.

Do not reuse empty container. Destroy it by perforating or crushing. Bury or discard in a safe place. (6 Gallon)

Do not reuse empty drum. Return to drum reconditioner or destroy by perforating or crushing and burying in a safe place. (30, 55 Gallon)
