

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Sanitizing the floors and equipment in the barns and poultry houses, poultry processing plants, and other applications. Puritan #5950 Disinfectant is a powerful germicide and deodorant. Sanitizing Poultry Drinking Water

Add 1 ounce of PURITAN #5950 DISINFECTANT to every 10 gallons of drinking water. The chlorine in the drinking water also helps keep the water free of algae and mineral deposits.

Food Plant Sanitization

Use 1 ounce of PURITAN #5950 DISINFECTANT in each 5 gallons of water as the final sanitizing rinse on previously cleaned food processing equipment and utensils. Drain, but do not rinse. When used at this dilution (1:640), PURITAN #5950 DISINFECTANT does not require a final potable water rinse, as prescribed in Federal Food Additive Regulation 121.2547.

Shoe Bath

To help prevent tracking disease organisms into poultry houses, brooding houses, and hatching places, place a shoe bath inside the doorway, containing 1 ounce of PURITAN #5950 DISINFECTANT per gallon of water. After carrying shoes outside doorway, stand in shoe bath for 30 seconds before re-entering brooding interior. Change shoe bath daily.

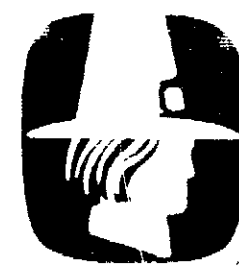

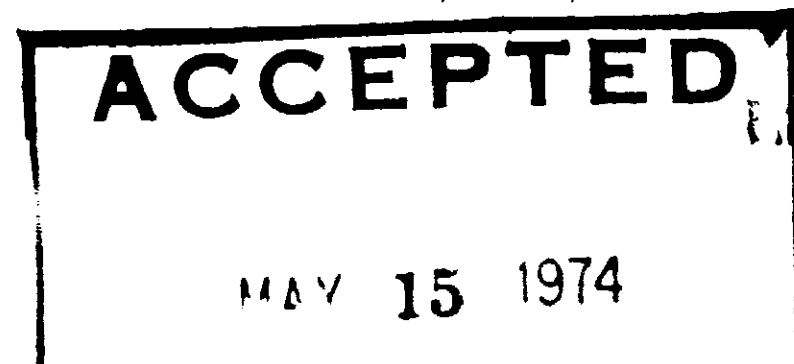

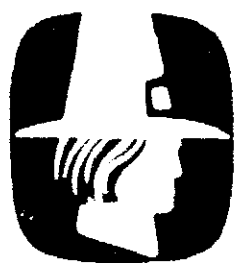

CONTAINER AND USE PREPARATION

Use Puritan #5950 disinfectant in poultry houses and other facilities and use it on drinking water. Empty and wash out containers thoroughly before use. Before use, wash out all surfaces thoroughly with water. Dilute with water. Use only for the purposes intended. Do not use on other types of equipment unless recommended. Use only on surfaces which are clean, shiny, smooth, and free of grease. Do not use on dirty surfaces. Do not use on metal surfaces until treatment has been completed. Do not use on untreated feed racks or troughs, troughs, automatic feeders, waterers, and waterers must be thoroughly rinsed with potable water prior to reuse. Thoroughly clean and disinfect in one easy step with PURITAN #5950 DISINFECTANT. Use one ounce of PURITAN #5950 DISINFECTANT per gallon of water. Scrub surfaces to be cleaned and disinfected with a good brush or with a power sprayer. Start at the highest point of the building or equipment being cleaned, and work down. Let solution drain dry without rinsing.

DANGER:

FIRST AID:

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, or other bland material. If these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Do not induce vomiting.

NOTE TO DISINFECTANT:

Prevent inhalation of fumes or vapors which may be used in a restricted area. The use of a respirator may be necessary in cases of respiratory depression, and medical attention may be needed.

WASH EMPTY CONTAINER THOROUGHLY WITH WATER AND DISCARD IT.
