

PURITAN #5955 DISINFECTANT has its own built-in indicator of germicidal activity. When the amber color disappears, a fresh solution should be prepared. This product is not adversely affected by water hardness or low temperatures. This product is tuberculocidal at a dilution of 3 ounces to 5 gallons of water.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** For general cleaning and disinfecting in one operation, first remove any gross filth or heavy soil deposits from surfaces; then, use solution of 3 ounces of PURITAN #5955 DISINFECTANT to 5 gallons of water. For porous or extremely dirty surfaces, use 6 ounces to 5 gallons of water.

For sanitizing previously-cleaned surfaces, use 1 ounce of PURITAN #5955 DISINFECTANT in 5 gallons of water.

**HOSPITALS:** Use as recommended above in cafeterias, operating areas, laboratories, morgues, patient rooms; for bedframes, walls and floors, thermometers, instruments, rubber gloves, tubing, and catheters; also in animal rooms and cages (after removing animals). Allow at least 10 minutes contact time. Rinse all food-handling surfaces with potable water before reuse. Before disinfecting, instruments should be cleaned to remove all adhering blood and serous exudates.

**COMMERCIAL BUILDINGS, INSTITUTIONS, AND GENERAL HOUSEKEEPING:** Use 3 ounces of PURITAN #5955 DISINFECTANT to 5 gallons of water for cleaning and disinfecting floors, walls, lavatories, shower rooms, refuse containers, kitchen areas, and lunch rooms. Rinse all food-handling equipment with potable water before reuse.

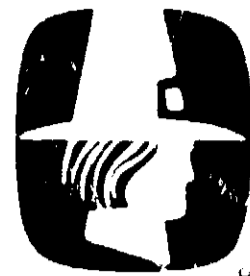

When used in this manner, PURITAN #5955 DISINFECTANT does not render potable water unfit for consumption with the Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act (21 CFR 125.47).

**DANGER:** IRRITATES EYES, CAUSES EYE DAMAGE AND SKIN IRRITATION. Avoid contact with eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Protect eyes and skin when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.
