

DIAZINON. AG-600 INSECTICIDE

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed - Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by leaning the back of the throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Call a physician immediately. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If inhaled - Remove victim to fresh air. Apply respiration if indicated.

If on skin - Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

If in eyes -- Flush eyes for at least 15 minutes with water. Call a physician immediately.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL STATEMENT

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

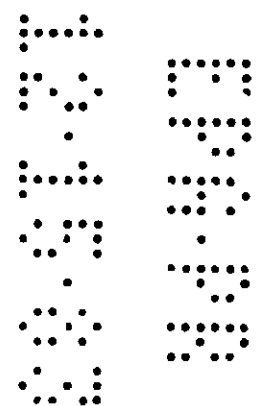

Your Applications Dated August 3 and December 12, 1983

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Since this product is subject to the child-resistant (special) packaging regulations, you must comply by either submitting a signed certification statement with associated recordkeeping or by addition of "FOR AGRICULTURAL USE ONLY" (in the same minimum type size as KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN) on the front panel beneath the product name if only non- orotic sales and use are the case for this product.

2. Revise the "If Swallowed" label to read:

If swallowed - Call a physician or Poison Center immediately. If possible, vomit. Do not induce vomiting unless directed by medical personnel. Do not use any laxatives or cathartics. Do not touch the mouth with anything. Do not induce vomiting or anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person.

3. The Environmental Hazards text should be revised to include the additional first paragraph that has appeared on the labeling prior to 1979, as follows:

This product is toxic to fish, shrimp, crabs, birds

and other wildlife. Birds and other animals may be killed. Keep out of rivers, streams, ponds, tidal marshes and estuaries. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as directed on this label.

The current label precaution will appear as the second paragraph of this section.

4. Revise the amount 7/10 pint which appears twice in the tobacco directions to appear as fluid ounces as requested in our letters of March 30, 1981 and April 29, 1986.
