To secure the best results from this insecticide the windows and doors
of the rooms to be sprayed should be closed and kept closed for one-half
hour after the insecticide has been sprayed. For every 500 cubic feet
use 4 ounces of insecticide, direct the spray thoroughly on joints, cracks
and crevices about the room.

This insecticide is a combination of pyrethrum extract and odorless oil
base giving a superior knock-down and killing power.

NOTE

Picknickers, campers and golfers will find this insecticide of some relief
in temporarily repelling flies and mosquitoes. Spray liberally around
shoes and various parts of clothing. Spray picnic benches liberally and
frequently.

To Kill Fleas:

Thoroughly spray floors, rugs and other flea in-
fested areas. Pay particular attention to animal
sleeping quarters in the household. Repeat spray-
ings as often as may be necessary.

To Kill Clothes Moths, Carpet Beetles

Take special precaution to see that cracks in floors
and openings below baseboards are thoroughly
wetted with spray liquid. Clothing to be stored
should be cleaned and aired and sprayed carefully
at a distance of one to two feet, taking care to
see that seams and folds are wetted. Chests in
which woollens are to be stored should be thor-
oughly sprayed before being filled with clothes.
Closets should be sprayed liberally at least twice
a month, directing the spray on the garments.

Always cover or remove foodstuffs before
spraying. Will not stain or discolor woodwork,
fabrics or furnishings when used as directed.

Keep all unprotected persons out of operational area while applying the insecticide, or working in treated areas during posted period. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs.
