STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Pesticide Disposal - Pesticide, spray mixture, or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to applicable Federal, state or local procedures

Container Disposal - Metal Containers: Triple rinse (or equivalent) Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other approved state and local procedures

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling

For control of Tent Caterpillars, Canker Worms, certain Leaf Miners and certain Scale Crawlers on ornamentals use 2 teaspoonfuls per gallon of water (2 pints in 100 gallons). Spray when insects appear and repeat when necessary. Do not apply to food crops later than 7 days before harvest. Injury may occur on certain ferns and some species of Crassula. May injure Bosc pears in Northeast. May injure McIntosh and Cortland varieties of apples if applied within four weeks of harvest

MOSQUITO CONTROL - For the control of adult mosquitoes, flies and small flying insects in outdoor areas dilute 1 to 28 with water (4 1/2 fl. oz per gallon). Apply as fine mist or fog. To spray building foundations, shrubs, low trees and lawn areas. Repeat application as necessary. May cause spotting on automobile paint finish. Cars should not be sprayed directly. If accidental exposure occurs, the car should be washed immediately

HOUSE FLIES: For reduction of fly population, use 2 gallons per 100 gallons of water, or 1 pint in 6 gallons of water for control in dairy barns, horse and sheep barns, poultry houses, corrals, manure piles, garbage heaps, city dumps, etc. apply spray thoroughly to wet ceiling, walls and other places where flies congregate. **FOR A BAIT SPRAY:** Use 2 gallons with 2 gallons unsulfurized molasses or corn syrup, or 20 pounds of sugar per 100 gallons of water. Repeat application as necessary.

NOTE: Do not use where milk is processed or stored or in human dwellings. Avoid contamination of feed products. **RE—MOVE ANIMALS AND POULTRY BEFORE TREATING DO NOT USE ON ANIMALS**

APPLES. Use 1 to 2 pints per 100 gallons of water for the control of European Red Mite, Two-Spotted Mite, Willamette Mite and Clover Mite, making two or more applications as needed. For the control of Woolly Apple Aphid, Green Apple Aphid and Rosy Apple Aphid make one or more applications as needed. **CAUTION:** May cause injury to McIntosh and Cortland varieties

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT
