USE DIRECTIONS

Apply CHAMPION DISINFECTANT CLEANER to walls, floors, and other hard surfaces such as tables, chairs and bed frames with a cloth or mop. For heavily soiled areas, a preliminary cleaning may be required.

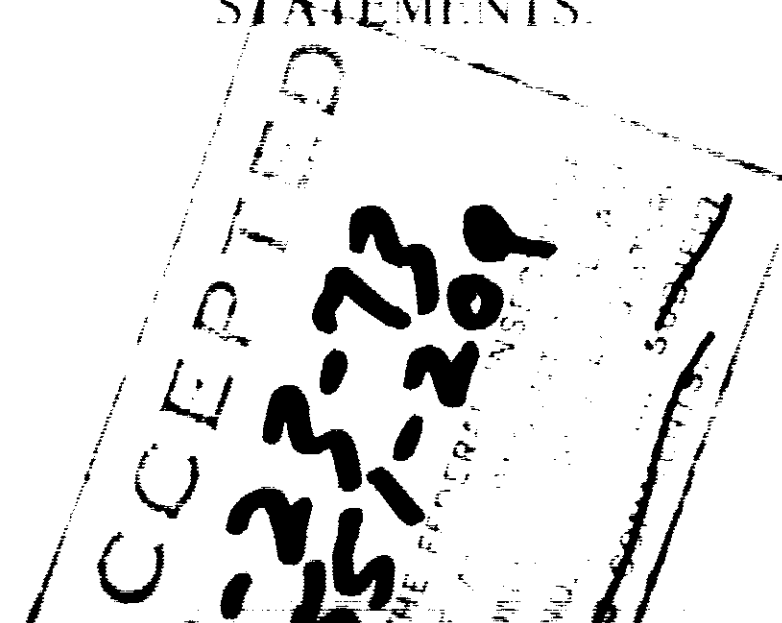
For Hospitals & Nursing Homes: Add two ounces per gallon of water.

At two ounces per gallon use-level, CHAMPION DISINFECTANT CLEANER is effective against *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*, *Staphylococcus aureus*, *Salmonella choleraesuis*, *Escherichia coli*, and pathogenic fungi. Germicidal performance against the first four organisms has been confirmed by the AOAC Use Dilution Test. Fungicidal performance was determined against *T. interdigitale* by the AOAC Fungicidal Test.

For Schools, Institutional and Industrial Uses: Add one ounce per gallon of water.

At one ounce per gallon use-level, CHAMPION DISINFECTANT CLEANER delivers excellent cleaning and is germicidal. It is effective against *Staphylococcus aureus*, *Salmonella choleraesuis*, *Escherichia coli*, and *Trichophyton interdigitale*, the athlete's foot fungus. The same AOAC tests used above to confirm similar performance for hospitals were used. Rinse empty container with water before discarding.

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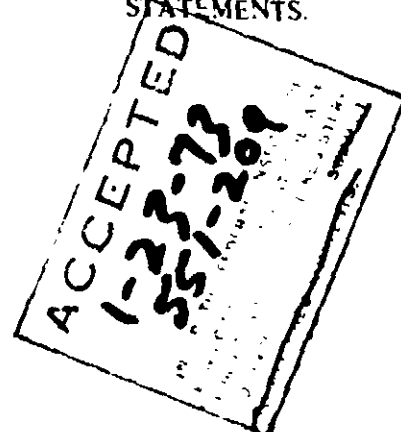
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
