Active Ingredients:
Pine Oil . . . 72%
Soap . . . 18%
Inert Ingredient:
Water . . . 10%

PURPOSES

This Disinfectant is especially prepared for disinfecting and cleaning purposes in public buildings, school houses, churches, theatres, restaurants, hotels, railway cars, steamships, clubs and private dwellings. Disinfectant to be used on hard surfaces such as bathroom fixtures, tile walls, tile floors—Not for use on Asphalt tile or linoleum surfaces.

DILUTION

Do not apply disinfectant until the majority of filth is removed by other means. For disinfecting and cleansing purposes, use 2½ tablespoons to 1 quart of water.

When preparing the solution, pour the disinfectant into the receptacle first, then add warm water and stir well. Never use boiling water.

APPLICATION

Apply with sponge, mop, or swab to wet surfaces thoroughly with the recommended use-dilution. It is preferable to apply the solution with a mop, but can be used with rags or cloths, which can be wrung out. When used according to directions, this Disinfectant disinfects, deodorizes, and cleanses all in one operation.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.
