For Disinfecting and Cleaning: Use 1 tablespoon to 1 quart of water.

Recommended for disinfecting and deodorizing poultry and animal shelter, pens, enclosures and handling equipment, also garbage handling equipment. Not to be used in food processing, storage or handling areas. Not recommended for hospital or medical use.

Do not apply Disinfectant until the majority of filth is removed by other means. Wear rubber gloves and use sponge, mop or swab to saturate surface being disinfected.

Do not use in milking stalls, milking parlors or milk houses. Remove all animals, poultry and feeds from premises, cars, boats, trucks, coops and crates. Remove all litter and manure from floors, walls, and surfaces of barns, pens, stalls, chutes, and other facilities and fixtures occupied or transversed by animals. Empty all troughs, racks, and other feeding and watering appliances. Saturate all surfaces with accepted disinfecting solution. Immerse all halters, ropes and other types of equipment used in handling and restraining animals as well as forks, shovels, and scrapers. Ventilate buildings, cars, boats, coops, and other closed spaces. Do not house poultry, livestock or employ equipment until treatment has been absorbed, set or dried. All treated feed racks, mangers, troughs, automatic feeders, fountains and waterers must be thoroughly scrubbed with detergents and rinsed with potable water prior to reuse.

DANGER

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

MAY BE FATAL IF SWALLOWED OR ABSORBED THROUGH SKIN! May produce severe burns! Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling.

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

If swallowed, drink promptly, a large quantity of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.
