Wheat, Oats, Barley and Rye - 3 fluid oz. per bushel. Corn, Soybeans and Sunflowers - 4 fluid oz. per bushel. Use only the recommended rate - lower amounts may not give the desired control. Higher amounts may cause seed injury. Seed should be well cured, dry and cleaned before treatment. For maximum benefits, avoid deep seeding and exceptionally early sowing under poor growing conditions.

Treat only those seeds needed for immediate use, minimizing the interval between treatment and planting. Do not store excess treated seeds beyond planting time. Treated seed must not be used for or mixed with food or animal feed, or processed for oil.
