CAUTION

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Apply in sufficient amount of water to give good coverage using ground or aerial sprays. Using ground application dilute with 25 - 100 gallons of water depending on type of spray equipment used. For aerial spray dilute with 5 - 10 gallons of water. The dosage to be used is dependent upon size of plants and incidence of disease or the threat of disease based on weather conditions reported by Agricultural Extension Service Specialists.

Potatoes--Early and late blight. Use every 7 to 10 days throughout the season. Begin application early. Apply 1 quart per acre when plants are small and increase to 1.6 quarts as plants get larger.

SugarBeets--Cercospora leaf spot. Use every 7 to 10 days at 1.2 to 2.4 quarts per acre when disease is threatened. Begin application early. Do not apply within 14 days of harvest. Do not feed treated tops to livestock.

Beans--Anthracnose, downy mildew, rust. Repeat 5 to 7 day intervals when disease first appears. Use at the rate of 0.8 to 2.4 quarts per acre. Use at the low rate when plants are small and increase to the high rate as plant canopy increases or threat of disease appears. Do not apply to succulent beans within 4 days of harvest.
