CAUTION

This product is toxic to fish. Cover or incorporate spilled treated seed. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Do not use this product in a manner different from the label directions. Do not apply directly to water, to areas where surface water is present, or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

DO NOT CONTAMINATE WATER, FOOD OR FEED BY STORAGE OR DISPOSAL.

STORAGE: Store in cool, dry location. Do not store in direct, hot sunlight.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. During mixing and loading, a chemical resistant apron, goggles, and a pesticide respirator jointly approved by MSH (Mine Safety and Health Administration) and by NIOSH (National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health) under the provisions of 30 CFR Part 11 for Lindane/Maneb protection must also be worn.

Important! Before removing gloves, wash them with soap and water. Always wash hands, face, and arms with soap and water before eating, smoking, or drinking and before using the toilet. After work take off all clothes and shoes. Shower using soap and water. Wear only clean clothes. Do not use contaminated clothing. Wash protective clothing and protective equipment with soap and water after each use. Personal clothing worn during use must be laundered separately from household articles. Clothing and protective equipment drenched with maneb must be destroyed

according to state and local regulations. Heavily contaminated or drenched clothing cannot be adequately decontaminated.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

AGSCO DUSTRET "A" is a fungicide formulated for the dry treatment of potato seed pieces to suppress Fusarium, Rhizoctonia, and Black Leg.

Whole or cut potato seed pieces should be thoroughly dusted with Dustret "A" at the rate of 1 lb. per 100 lbs. of seed. Apply so that the cut seed pieces are thoroughly covered with dust by the use of a convenient container or dust attachment over the belt. Do not use this product at higher than recommended rate.

Thoroughly clean and sanitize cutting machines, knives, trays, tables, barrels, equipment, trucks and planters before cutting and planting seed pieces. If seed potatoes have not sprouted, subject them to temperatures of 50 to 60 degrees F for about 10 to 15 days before handling. Treat the warmed seed pieces immediately after they are cut. The cut and treated seed pieces should be held for a week or more at cool temperatures and high relative humidity; however, they may be planted immediately. This holding period promotes suberization and allows the cut surfaces to heal.

USE RESTRICTIONS

Do not use treated seed pieces for food, feed, or fodder. This pesticide is to be sold ONLY in its original, unbroken package. If this product is used on a crop, no other product containing a different EBDC active ingredient may be used on the same crop during the same growing season.

DISCLAIMER FOR SEED TREATMENT

The treatment of mechanically damaged seed or the treatment of seed known to have low vigor or poor quality may result in reduced germination and/or reduction of seed and seedling vigor. Treat and conduct your own germination tests on a small portion of seed before committing the total seed lot to a selected chemical treatment. Due to seed quality conditions beyond the control of AGSCO, INC., no guarantees are made concerning germination of treated seed.
