

CAUTION

AGSCO DUSTRET "A" is a fungicide formulated for the dry treatment of potato seed pieces to suppress Fusarium, Rhizoctonia, and Black Leg.

Whole or cut potato seed pieces should be thoroughly dusted with AGSCO DUSTRET "A" at the rate of 1 lb. per 100 lbs. of seed. Apply so that the cut seed pieces are thoroughly covered with dust by the use of a convenient container or dust attachment over the belt. Do not use this product at higher than recommended rate.

Thoroughly clean and sanitize cutting machines, knives, trays, tables, barrels, equipment, trucks and planters before cutting and planting seed pieces. If seed potatoes have not sprouted, subject them to temperatures of 50 to 60 degrees F for about 10 to 15 days before handling. Treat the warmed seed pieces immediately after they are cut. The cut and treated seed pieces should be held for a week or more at cool temperatures and high relative humidity; however, they may be planted immediately. This holding period promotes suberization and allows the cut surfaces to heal.

USE RESTRICTIONS

Do not use treated seed pieces for food, feed, or fodder. This pesticide is to be sold ONLY in its original, unbroken package.
