Weeds are hard to kill when weather is cold in the early spring or during hot, dry summer weather. For best results, apply while lawn is wet with dew or after sprinkling lightly. Apply several days after mowing to allow for the presence of plenty of leaf surface to catch and retain Swift Lawn Weeder & Feeder, then do not mow or water lawn for another day. Set your spreader as shown below, then cover your lawn evenly.

The maximum application rate for this product is 4.0 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. The maximum number of broadcast applications per treatment site is 2 per year.

Approximately 4 weeks after weed kill is evident, an application of 16% or higher nitrogen fertilizer should be made at a rate of 6 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. and watered in well.
