Apply when dichondra foliage is dry. To avoid possibility cupshaped leaves will trap and hold enough fertilizer to cause temporary injury, water in.

TO CONTROL WEEDS EARLY: Apply in early spring before crabgrass germinates. Susceptible weed seedlings will be killed as they sprout. Apply again in fall. May be applied regularly with no harm to mature or germinating dichondra. Frequent use insures against weeds.

TO CONTROL MATURE BERMUDA GRASS: Apply in early spring when bermuda starts. Will be greatly reduced and weakened. Overseed with dichondra to help crowd out the bermuda. A second application should be made in the fall. Fall applications are most effective.

FOR NEW DICHONDRA LAWNS: Rake into seed bed. Plant seed. Will not harm germination of dichondra seeds. Do not incorporate a soil insect control at this time -- wait until dichondra is established.

WEEDS CONTROLLED: Crabgrass, bermuda, bluegrass, chickweed (common), foxtail, red sorrel, pigweed, knotweed, lambsquarter, goosegrass, stinkgrass, carpetweed, barnyard grass.
