HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARD

Atrazine can leech through soil and can enter groundwater which may be used as drinking water. Atrazine has been found in groundwater. Users are advised not to apply atrazine to soil and heavy sand soils where the water table (groundwater) is close to the surface and where these soils are very permeable, i.e., well-drained. Your local agricultural extension can provide further information on the type of soil in your area and the location of groundwater. This pesticide is toxic to aquatic invertebrates. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands. Runoff and drift from treated areas may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in neighboring areas. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

Do not use north of North Carolina. Do not use on berm of Bahiagrass, Bermudagrass, Dichondra, Bergrass, or Carpetgrass or where clover is present and desired.

Avoid application to the root zone of trees and shrubs. Avoid applications on garden plants, flowers and shrubs. Delay spring planting for one month after application. Do not apply in areas underlaid by roots of desirable trees and shrubs. Clean spreader after use.

Apply only in Winter, Spring and Fall. This product is not recommended for use during the months of July, August and September.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For best results apply before weeds come up (pre-emergent). Established weeds are more difficult to control and may require an application in Spring and Fall. On newly sprigged St. Augustine, Crab

grass or Zoysia Lawns, apply immediately after planting to prevent weeds from starting growth. Use Pesticides properly. Do not overuse. Read directions for use carefully. Most is soil. Apply between January 1 and March 31 (Florida and other southern states to June 15th).

Storage: Store in original container in safe, dry place. Do not contaminate other pesticides, fertilizers, seeds, food or feed. Return spillage to original container prior to disposal.

Product Disposal: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. **Container Disposal:** Do not reuse bag. Discard bag in trash.

CONTROLS THESE WEEDS

Germinating Crabgrass, Bermudagrass, Wiergrass, Paspalum Seedlings (Dallisgrass, Vaseygrass, Bahiagrass), Sedges (such as Cyperus Compressus) and Spurge.

Established and Germinating: Broom, Blackspur, Yellow, White, Burdock, Chickweed, Dandelion, Quail, Florida Pusley, Pigweed (Dallisgrass) and Crabgrass (Blackgrass).
