DUSTING INSTRUCTIONS: Just Squeeze to Apply

Best results are secured by dusting regularly at 7-10 day intervals throughout the growing season (more frequently in rainy weather). Apply in early morning or late evening when the air is quiet. Cover all exposed parts of plant with a thin even film of dust. Canister should be held in a horizontal position (not upside down) while dusting to avoid over-application. A thin, even coating is all that is required for protection.

CAUTION

AVOID INHALING DUST. Do not use within 7 days of harvest on beet tops used for food, beans, cabbage, cauliflower, spring onions, and spinach. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest on broccoli, brussel sprouts, collards, kale, swiss chard, and leaf lettuce or within 5 days of harvest on head lettuce. Do not apply within 24 hours of harvest on beets, cucurbits, and tomatoes.

Sulfur may burn foliage when temperatures are excessively high. Do not use sulfur on cucumbers, melons, or squash unless local experience has shown that sulfur is safe on such plants.
