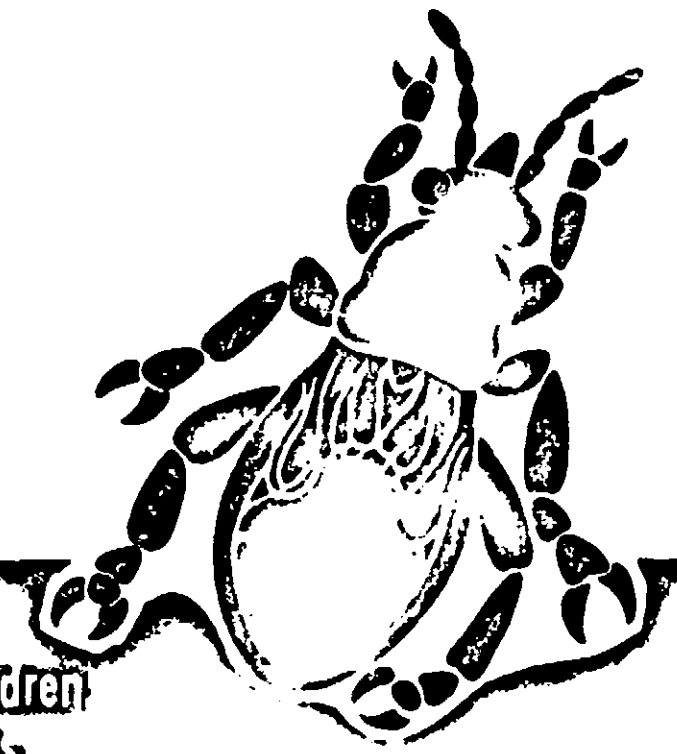

CHINCH BUG KILLER

CAUTION

Do not use, pour, spill or store near heat or open flame.

May be absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with eyes or clothes. Avoid breathing spray mist and skin contact. In case of contact, wash immediately with soap and water. Avoid contamination of food and foodstuffs. Do not use on household pets or humans. Keep away from children and pets. Harmful if swallowed.

Do not allow children or pets to play on treated lawn until residue has been washed off the grass and into the ground and grass is dry.

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Birds feeding on treated areas may be killed. Keep out of lakes, streams, or ponds. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from areas treated. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply only as specified on this label.

Do not reuse this container. Wash thoroughly with water and detergent. Discard in a safe place.

SPRAYER EQUIPMENT

GARDEN HOSE SPRAYERS: Such as the Instant Vigoro Lawn Gun that are gauged to apply 15 to 20 gallons to empty a one-quart jar, give better penetration into the grass and are best suited for lawn. Simply mix one pint of Vigoro Chinch Bug Killer and one pint of water in the jar and use as directed.

PRESSURE SPRAYERS: Any type satisfactory that will deliver 15 to 20 gallons of water to 500 square feet. Mix one pint of Vigoro Chinch Bug Killer into 15 to 20 gallons of water and use as directed.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

LAWN CHINCH BUGS—Apply 2-3 pints of Vigoro Chinch Bug Killer in 15 to 20 gallons of water to 1000 square feet of lawn area. For longer residual control in St. Augustine lawns, use 3-6 pints. Repeat after 10 to 14 days to kill newly hatched bugs. For best results, sprinkle lawn thoroughly with water immediately before applying and spray entire lawn.

ANTS, ARMYWORMS, SOD WEBWORMS, CUTWORMS—Apply 2 quarts of Vigoro Chinch Bug Killer in 15 to 20 gallons of water to 1000 square feet of lawn area. Repeat as needed. For best results sprinkle lawn before applying and spray entire lawn. Grass should be examined every few days for young worms.

BROWN DOG TICKS, FLEAS, CHIGGERS, LEAFHOPPERS—Apply 1 pint of Vigoro Chinch Bug Killer in 15 to 20 gallons of water to 1000 square feet. For best results, sprinkle lawn before applying and spray entire lawn. Grass should be examined every few days for young worms. Repeat as needed.

MILLIPEDES—Apply 1 gallon of Vigoro Chinch Bug Killer in 15 to 20 gallons of water to 1000 square feet of lawn area. Repeat as needed.
