VIGORO CHINCHBUG & SOD WEBWORM KILLER

Vigoro Chinchbug & Sod Webworm Killer is a water emulsifiable concentrate designed to kill chinchbugs and sod webworms. It mixes readily with water and is especially designed for use in hose sprayers.

Garden hose sprayers such as the Vigoro Lawn Weed-N-Feed Sprayer that are gauged to apply 15 to 20 gallons to empty one quart jar will provide good coverage and penetration. Other similar type sprayers will do a satisfactory job.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE ON LAWNS

It is very important to use according to directions. Otherwise serious injury may occur to plants or persons.

CHINCHBUGS: Apply 1/2 pint of this product in 15 to 20 gallons of water to 500 square feet of lawn (an area 50' x 10'). Apply when activity or damage appears (yellowing, thinning or browning of grass often develops in spots and then spreads out over the lawn). To prevent damage, apply as soon as daily temperatures reach 80° F. and repeat every two months. Be sure the spray penetrates heavily matted turf to obtain maximum kill. Thorough watering before application is helpful. Do not mow for 24 hours following treatment.

SOD WEBWORMS: Use 1/2 pint of this product in 15 to 20 gallons of water to 500 square feet of lawn area for normal lawn and turf for treatment. Apply twice a year, first in early fall and second in early spring. Thorough watering before application is helpful.

In case of breakage, cover immediately with sufficient garden soil or any other absorptive materials to thoroughly soak up liquid. Sweep and bury. Wash area thoroughly with soap and water containing household ammonia.

All disposable metal and glass containers should be punctured or broken and disposed of by burying at approved dump or sanitary landfill. This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Keep out of any body of water.

This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to it during the part of their lives when they are foraging. For more information, contact your local Agricultural Extension Service.

FIRST AID TREATMENT

ANTIDOTE: If swallowed, give a large amount of water or milk or warm water and repeat until vomited. Induce vomiting with 1/2 cup of 3% hydrogen peroxide. Do not induce vomiting if victim is unconscious. Call a physician immediately.

If on skin, in case of contact, remove contaminated clothing and immediately wash skin with soap and water.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Active ingredient is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine is an antidote.
