DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Apply GRO-TONE Crabgrass Preventer plus Lawn Fertilizer early in the spring. This should be done one to two weeks prior to the germination of annual grass weeds since it kills crabgrass and weed seedlings just as they are sprouting from the seed. It will not control established weeds.

1. Make area free of leaves and other debris prior to application.
2. Apply contents of this bag to 5,000 sq. ft. for northern (cool season) turfgrasses.
3. Apply contents of this bag to 3,750 sq. ft. for southern (warm season) turfgrasses.
4. It is essential to apply very evenly with no skips or misses. Calibrate and check application equipment prior to use. Set spreader according to chart below and apply evenly to the area. Check frequently to ensure equipment is working properly and distributing product uniformly.
5. Water in after application for optimum weed control.

Approximately 4 weeks after initial treatment with product, an application of 16% or higher nitrogen fertilizer should be made at a rate of 6 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. and watered in well.

With these use directions, the following weeds in established turf are controlled: crabgrass, foxtails and barnyard grass with an application in spring; goosegrass with a late spring or early summer application; annual bluegrass (Poa Annua) in northern areas with a late summer and early spring application.

Gro-Tone Crabgrass Preventer plus Lawn Fertilizer is tolerant to the following turfgrasses with these use directions:

PRECAUTIONS: This product may thin established annual bluegrass and fine-leaved fescues and should not be applied in the spring to turfgrasses planted the previous fall. Do not apply to bermudagrass putting greens or dichondras. Avoid any cultural practices that disturb the soil such as raking, sanding or verticutting after application of this product. Reseeding of treated areas should be delayed for at least 6 weeks after applying this product.

STORAGE: Store in original container in safe, dry place. Do not contaminate other pesticides, fertilizer, seeds, food or feed. Return spillage to original container prior to disposal.

PRODUCT DISPOSAL: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
