

DIRECTIONS


For All General Disinfection of walls, floors, counters, appliances or other environmental surfaces use 75 ppm Titratable Iodine; this is a solution containing 1 ¼ ounces of DYODYNE/gallon of water. Apply this solution with a mop, sponge or brush and in sufficient quantity to thoroughly wet surfaces. Use to scrub surfaces and pick up the spent use-solution.

For Sanitizing walls, floors and other inanimate surfaces in restaurants, bars, breweries or dairy and food processing plants use 50 ppm Titratable Iodine; this is a solution containing 1.0 ounces of DYODYNE/gallon of water. Apply this solution to pre-cleaned surfaces; use in sufficient amounts to flood surfaces. Let solution stand, then flush surfaces with a potable water rinse.
