**TOILET ROOMS, COMMODES, and URINALS**: Wash the commode and urinal bowl regularly with a solution of 3 1/2 Tablespoons of disinfectant in each gallon of water, leaving the solution in the rommode and urinal as long as possible. Scrub the floor and seat frequently with this solution. emove residual bowl water from toilet before application of disinfectant.
