This product is especially recommended for use in stables, barns and outbuildings, apartment buildings, households, schools, office buildings, industrial plants, for disinfecting floors, walls, sinks, bathrooms, toilets, urinals, and outhouses. Can be used as a deodorant which is noticeable from 1 3 hours after use.

It is instantly soluble in water, forming a milky white emulsion which does not separate on standing. When mixed with water in recommended dilution does not stain the walls, floors, or clothes, and leaves a pleasant and fragrant odor of pine.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR DISINFECTING PREMISES: Remove gross filth from surfaces prior to disinfecting. Prepare a solution of 3 1/2 Tablespoons of disinfectant to one gallon of water. Wet surface thoroughly with the disinfecting solution and allow to remain for 10 minutes.

FLOORS: When mopping or scrubbing, use 3 1/2 Tablespoons of disinfectant in each gallon of water in bucket.

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TOILET ROOMS, COMMODES, and URINALS: Wash the commode and urinal bowl regularly with a solution of 3 1/2 Tablespoons of disinfectant in each gallon of water, leaving the solution in the commode and urinal as long as possible. Scrub the floor and seat frequently with this solution. Remove residual bowl water from toilet before application of disinfectant.

GARBAGE RECEPTACLES: To aid in deodorization, sprinkle with a solution in the proportion of 4 Tablespoons of disinfectant to a gallon of water. Rinse the empty can with some of the solution and leave the wash in the can.

TYPHOID SICKROOM: In the disinfecting of bed frames, floors, walls, bed pans, clothing, bed clothes, utensils, use 6 Tablespoons per gallon. Soak clothing and bed clothes in recommended use dilution before laundering. For utensils and bed pans follow with a rinse of potable water.
