# **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. For best results, plants should be dusted as soon as pests appear and repeated at seven day intervals. Proper application and as complete coverage as possible helps to secure successful control of insect pests. A good hand or power duster of the usual type is satisfactory for use. Both lower and upper sides of the plant leaves should be thoroughly dusted. The kind and age of the plants being treated will determine the amount of dust required. The quantity will vary from ½ pound to 1 pound per 1,000 square feet. ROCKLAND ROTENONE 1% DUST should be applied in dry weather. Howe er, the plants must not necessarily be dry as its effectiveness is not lost on wet plants.

The maximum kill is obtained in 1 to 3 days with effectiveness lasting a number of days depending on weather conditions.




