**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

Scale: 1 fluid ounce = 2 tablespoons  
16 ounces = 1 pint

Use ROCKLAND CHLORDANE 73% at the rate of 1 1/2 pints in sufficient water to cover 1000 square feet of established lawn. It is for use as an early season preventive treatment and is not effective for the control of crabgrass plants. Timing of application is important and **MUST BE APPLIED BEFORE GERMINATION** which in the metropolitan New York area is about April 15. This treatment will not burn or injure established lawns. If there is any question as to timing of application in your area consult your county agricultural agent.

Keep children and pets off treated areas until this material has been thoroughly washed into the soil and the grass has completely dried.

**ANTS**—ROCKLAND CHLORDANE 73 kills ants by direct contact. Add 3 ounces CHLORDANE 73 to one gallon of water and spray foundation walls, ant trails, around door sills, window frames and where the pests may enter the premises.

**ROACHES, WATERBUGS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS, CARPET BEETLES**—ROCKLAND CHLORDANE 73 gives fast initial control and long periods of protection against re-infestation. Mix 3 ounces in each gallon of water and spray infested cracks, baseboards and other suspected hiding places. For carpet beetles be certain to treat the underside and top edges of carpeting. Care should be exercised when spraying to prevent staining and damage to household furnishings and varnished or painted surfaces.

**SUB-SURFACE SOIL INFESTING INSECTS IN LAWNS AND TURF:** Ants, Japanese Beetle Grubs, Wireworms, Cutworms, White Grubs—Use 3 ounces of CHLORDANE 73 per 1,000 square feet in an amount your spray equipment is able to distribute. It is important that at least 25 gallons of water per 1,000 square feet be applied.

**CHIGGER CONTROL**—For lawns and other grassy areas, mix 1 1/2 ounces ROCKLAND CHLORDANE 73 with each 2 gallons of water and apply this mixture on 1,000 square feet.

**FLOWER GARDEN AND SHRUB INFESTING INSECTS**—TO KILL Army Worms, Plant and Spittle Bugs, Flea Beetles, Leaf Miners, Thrips, Pea Aphids.

**CAUTION** — On plants which utilize pollinators, make application in the evening or early morning when pollinators are not active. Repeat applications whenever necessary.

**FLOWER GARDEN AND SHRUB INFESTING INSECTS** (see list) — Mix 4 ounces ROCKLAND CHLORDANE 73 to 48 gallons of water (1/2 teaspoonful to 1 gallon of water) and thoroughly spray all foliage, including stems, and if possible, directly on the ground.

**WARNING** — Contact with skin can cause toxic symptoms. Avoid breathing spray mist or skin contact. In case of spillage on skin, wash with soap and water. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. May be fatal if swallowed. Keep out of reach of children: Do not spray into or near open flame. Do not smoke while spraying.
