CAUTION - COMBUSTIBLE MIXTURE

Do not spray near or into open flames. Harmful if swallowed. Keep out of reach of children. Do not use in areas where food is prepared or stored. Wash hands after use.

"PENN-MIST" contains a high percentage of a pyrethroid insecticide but is safe for use on mammals.

"PENN-MIST" will not stain clothing, paper, upholstery, or other materials. Do not spray directly on or within four feet from the subject. Use caution on wet fabrics with labels.

All wetted fabrics dry before using.

"PENN-MIST", when sprayed properly, will not contaminate cooking utensils, food products or tableware. To avoid wetting of case dishes, etc., remove or cover food or utensils. Do not spray directly on food or food stuffs.

Remove birds, pets and fish bowls before spraying room.

In Food Processing Plants, food should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. When using the product as a (case spray) do not re-apply until when plant is not in operation.

Do not use empty containers. Destroy by perforating or crushing. Bury in a safe place far away from water supply.

DO NOT USE, POUR, SPILL OR STORE NEAR HEAT OR OPEN FLAME.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

TO KILL FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS: Close windows and doors. Spray in the premises thoroughly with water at rate of 2 ounces per 100 cubic feet. Keep insects dead for at least 10 minutes after spraying. Sweep up and remove dead insects. Repeat spraying as often as necessary.

TO KILL ROACHES, WATER BUGS, SILVERFISH: Spray thoroughly and multiply the dose (use 1/2 oz. per 100 cu. ft.) in refrigerator, play area, etc., in treatment of cracks and crevices wherever roaches are likely to hide. Spray in the kitchen for cockroaches as required.

NET CONTENTS:

TO KILL BEDBUGS: Spray thoroughly with "Penn-Mist" in a room. If bedbugs are found with you, spray with "Penn-Mist" in the room. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL FLYING MOTHS AND AID IN MOTH CONTROL: Spray thoroughly with "Penn-Mist" in areas where moths are kept. Fog room with heavy mist or fog. Spray in closets, drawers, etc., with care not to wet clothing. Give special attention to upper open cuffs, seams, etc., where moths are likely to be found. After treatment, dry, keep room, etc., etc., closed for 30 minutes. Repeat at least every 30 days. For storage treated with "Penn-Mist" containers, moisture proof bag, mark with "Penn-Mist" thoroughly without wetting. Seal.

TO KILL EXPOSED STAGES OF CEREAL INSECTS: Cereal, Cigarette Beetle, Germanic, Drug Store Beetle, Indian Meal Moth, Mediterranean Flour Moth, Red Flour Beetle, Sawtoothed Grain Beetle, and Weevils. Clean bins and grain bins and floors. Spray thoroughly with "Penn-Mist" in a room, dry, keep room, etc., closed for 30 minutes. Repeat as often as required.

TO CONTROL CARPET BEETLE: Spray thoroughly with "Penn-Mist" in a room, dry, keep room, etc., closed for 30 minutes. Repeat as required.

FOR CHEESE MITES AND CHOCOLATE MOTHS: Spray thoroughly with "Penn-Mist" in a room, dry, keep room, etc., closed for 30 minutes. Repeat as required.

WARRANTY: "Penn-Mist" is warranted to be effective against the insects listed on the label. If it is not effective, a full refund will be made. However, no refund will be made for insects listed on the label which are not listed on the label.
