

Statement of Practical Treatment

IF SWALLOWED: call a physician or poison control center. Do not induce vomiting. Drink large quantities of milk, egg whites or gelatin solution. If these materials are not available, drink large quantities of water. This product contains petroleum solvents. Aspiration may be a hazard. IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing. Wash affected area with soap and water. Launder clothes before re-using. IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: Remove birds, pets and fish bowls before spraying room. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

TO KILL FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS: Close windows and other openings. Spray or fog premises thoroughly using approximately 2 ounces per 1,000 cubic feet. Keep area closed for at least 10 minutes after spraying. Sweep up and remove dead insects. Repeat fogging as often as necessary.

TO KILL ROACHES, WATER BUGS, SILVERFISH: Spray liberally around pantry storage shelves, cabinets, sinks, refrigerators, paying particular attention to cracks and crevices or wherever roaches are likely to hide. Spray once each day for 10 days; then spray as required.

TO KILL BEDBUGS: Spray entire room thoroughly creating a heavy fog or mist. Spray mattresses with particular emphasis on tufts and seams. Spray all parts of bedstead, cracks and crevices in and around baseboards, loose wallpaper, wherever bedbugs are likely to hide. Repeat as required.

TO KILL FLYING MOTHS AND AID IN MOTH CONTROL: Spray rooms, closets, other open areas where clothes are kept. Fill room with heavy mist or fog. Spray closets thoroughly directly on clothing, with care not to wet clothing. Give special attention to lapels, open cuffs, seam, etc., where moths are likely to be found. After thorough spraying, keep rooms, closets, etc., closed for 30 minutes. Repeat at least every 30 days. For storing treated clothes in sealed containers, mothproof bags, trunks, etc., spray containers thoroughly without wetting. Seal.

TO KILL EXPOSED STAGES OF CEREAL INSECTS: Cadelles, Cigarette Beetles, Dermestids, Drugstore Beetles, Indian Meal Moths, Mediterranean Flour Moths, Red Flour Beetles, Saw-toothed Grain Beetles and Weevils. Clean flour and grain bins and chutes. Spray thoroughly with special emphasis to forcing spray into cracks and checks of ceiling, walls and floor in order to penetrate hiding places of insects. Repeat as often as required.

TO CONTROL CARPET BEETLE: Spray rug thoroughly, underside as well as top side. Do not wet. Spray around baseboards and floors. Repeat as required.

FOR CHEESE MITES AND CHOCOLATE MOTHS: Spray rooms thoroughly before storing forcing spray into cracks and crevices in floors and walls. Cover exposed foods. Keep doors closed for 20 minutes. Repeat as required.

IN FOOD PROCESSING PLANTS: Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before using. When using the product in these areas, apply only when plant is not in operation.
