Dear Ms. Lemm:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the following changes to your label:

a) On page 4 of the label (as per EPA letter dated 28 Feb 1997) you must delete the statement in Directions for Use on Corn: "Make 3 to 4 applications at 2-3 day intervals as infestation warrants. Re-apply immediately after rain." You may want to change this statement to something similar to: "Make applications at 7 day intervals until silks begin to dry. Three or more applications may be required depending upon severity of infestation."

2. Submit two copies of your final printed labeling including the change above and the deletion of tree use before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A copy of the labeling stamped "Accepted with Comments" is enclosed for your records.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Carbaryl is a moderate, reversible cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:** This pesticide is extremely toxic to aquatic and estuarine invertebrates. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on blooming crops or weeds. Do not apply this product or allow it to drift to blooming crops or weeds if bees are visiting the treatment area.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**STORAGE:** Store unused material, in original container only, in a locked storage area out of reach of children and animals. Keep container tightly closed. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

**DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Securely wrap in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

ROCKLAND 5% SEVIN DUST is finely ground to give a superior dusting quality. To control insects listed below, dust at the recommended rates, making certain to cover foliage uniformly and completely paying particular attention to the undersides of the leaves.

**SUBSEQUENT PLANTING OF FOOD AND FEED CROPS IN TREATED SOIL MUST BE MADE WITH CROPS ON THIS OR OTHER CARBARYL LABELS.**

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Wearing household latex or rubber gloves, use a dust applicator such as a shaker can, dust gun, puffer or other bulbous duster, rotary duster or other appropriate duster available. Dust lightly to cover both upper and lower leaf surfaces with a thin, even film of dust.

Apply when air is calm to avoid drift and contact with eyes and skin.

Start applying at the farthest corner of the treatment area and work backward to avoid contact with dusted surfaces. Allow dust to settle in treated areas before reentering.

For plants above chest height, consider using a liquid SEVIN® product.

Do not repeat applications more than once a week.
