DIRECTIONS FOR USE

ROCKLAND "HOMEOWNER" GARDEN DUST is finely ground to give a superior dusting quality. To control Insects and Diseases listed below, dust at the recommended rates, making certain to cover foliage uniformly and completely, paying particular attention to the undersides of the leaves.

Dust when insects or diseases appear and continue every 7 to 10 days as necessary.

FLOWERS and ORNAMENTALS: Dust ROCKLAND "HOMEOWNER" GARDEN DUST at rate of 8 oz. to 1 lb. per 1000 sq. ft. or 20 to 40 lbs. per acre, to control Bagworm, Japanese Beetles, Flea Beetles, Lace Bugs, Leafhoppers, Scale Insects, Rose Aphid, Tent Caterpillar on Andromeda, Arbor Vitae, Ash, Aster, Azalea, Bamboo, Beech, Begonia, Birch, Boxwood, Camellia, Carnation, Ceanothus, Cedar, Chinese Elm, Chrysanthemum, Cypress, Dahlia, Delphinium, Dogwood, Elm, Euonymus, Fir, Fuchsia, Gladiolus, Hemlock, Hickory, Holly, Hornbeam, Hydrangea, Fern, Maple, Marigold, Nasturtium, Oak, Orchid, Ornamental Mulberry, Petunia, Pine, Poplar, Privet, Rhododendron, Rose, Sassafras, Spirea, Verbena, Viburnum, Willow, Wisteria, Yew, Zinnia. Controls Early and Late Blight, Anthracnose, STEMPHYLIUM and CLADOSPORIUM Gray Mold on Tomato; Anthracnose CERCOSPORA Leaf Spot on Eggplant and Pepper.

BEANS: Dust at the rate of 20 to 40 lbs. per acre (8 ozs. to 1 lb. per 1000 sq. ft.). When Lygus Bugs are present use 40 lbs.
